

# Garden City Center Internship Application



## Internship Program

We offer internships to students who are currently enrolled in a masters program in counseling or therapy and have completed their first year of coursework. Interns will offer direct clinical services to Garden City clients.

## Internship Requirements

- Each intern will work with Garden City Clinical staff to determine a schedule and client load. A minimum of 5 client hours per week is requested.
- Weekly consultation meeting with Garden City Clinical Staff members
- Monthly Staff Meetings
- The intern is responsible for ensuring that all of their school requirements are met (Intern is responsible for these, not Garden City).
- Garden City may provide supervision to interns depending on the program requirements. The intern is responsible to understand and check with their program on approved supervisors.

## Christian Component

Qualified Interns are those who:

- Understand Christian context with regards to theology, doctrine, Church community, interpersonal relationships among Christians, intrapersonal relationship between a person and the Triune God, and family dynamics with regards to faith communities.
- Respect for diverse Christian faith practices and non-Christian beliefs.

- How would you describe your faith? Are there specific doctrines (such as the Apostles' Creed or the Nicene Creed) or denominations that you resonate with?
- Our stance at Garden City is to be accepting of all (and having a client-led approach to faith in the therapy space) and we work with a diversity of clients, in all senses of the term. What is your interest in diversity?
